An Act relating to public health and safety;
requiring certain action by Statewide Emergency
911 Advisory Committee; providing for
codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2818.4 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Statewide Emergency 911 Advisory Committee shall, in
developing its recommendations pursuant to Section 2818.3 of Title
63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, consider the presumption that all
providers of dial tone are obligated to participate in the provision
of 911 service and its funding.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
