An Act relating to state government; authorizing and encouraging the Director of the Department of Transportation to engage in certain negotiations regarding contracts for the use of certain rights of way; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Director of the Department of Transportation is authorized and encouraged to engage in collaborative negotiation in behalf of this state with officials of other states of this nation, the United States Government, the state and federal governments of Mexico, and the provincial and national governments of Canada in regard to entering into contracts for the use of rights of way along Interstate Highway No. 35, and along highways joining it, for fiber optic cable and other communication and telecommunication devices.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
