An Act relating to regulation of natural resources; providing for appropriations to the Oklahoma Conservation Commission; specifying purposes and expenditures therefor; designating certain uses and purposes; making certain appropriations subject to fiscal year limitations; providing lapse dates; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Conservation Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$260,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to maintain and improve the safety of upstream flood control structures in conservation districts.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Conservation Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to provide enhanced support of conservation districts.

SECTION 3. Funds provided for in this act to the Oklahoma Conservation Commission may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996 (hereafter FY-96) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997 (hereafter FY-97). Funds budgeted for FY-96 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1996, and must be expended by November 15, 1996. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1996, and not budgeted for FY-97, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-97 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1997. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1997, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-96, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-97, after the agencies have prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-96 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 1995.
