An Act relating to tourism and recreation;
amending Section 67, Chapter 189, O.S.L. 1993,
as amended by Section 3, Chapter 274, O.S.L.
1994, which relates to bond proceeds; changing
location of tourist information center; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 67, Chapter 189, O.S.L.
1993, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 274, O.S.L. 1994, is amended
to read as follows:

Section 3. The funds appropriated in Section 66 of this act
shall be allocated by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department
