An Act relating to the State Department of Agriculture; requiring Department to establish planting and harvesting seasons; requiring certain notice; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-28 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Department of Agriculture is hereby directed to establish planting and harvesting seasons for the purpose of meeting the maximum driving and on-duty time exemptions set forth in the National Highway System Designation Act of 1995, and shall notify the U.S. Secretary of Transportation of such seasons within sixty (60) days of the passage of this act.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
