An Act relating to funding public records and information agencies; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries; stating purposes; requiring certain budgeting of all funds; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; making appropriations to the Secretary of State; stating purposes; providing for duties and compensation of employees; providing budgetary limitations; providing lapse dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budgeting procedures; repealing Section 45 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 837 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to an appropriation for the Office of Volunteerism; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF LIBRARIES

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the Department of Libraries shall budget all funds in the following categories:

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-eight Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-seven Dollars (\$58,227.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. The Oklahoma Department of Libraries for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECRETARY OF STATE

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of Fifty-one Thousand Seven Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$51,717.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Secretary of State by law.

SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Secretary of State by law shall be set by the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act for the operation of the Oklahoma Department of Libraries or the Secretary of State, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997 (hereafter FY-97) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998 (hereafter FY-98). Funds budgeted for FY-97 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1997, and must be expended by November 15, 1997. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1997, and not budgeted for FY-98, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-98 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1998, and must be expended by November 15, 1998. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. The appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-97, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-98, after the Department of Libraries or the Secretary of State has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-97 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 7. REPEALER Section 45 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 837 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This act shall become effective September 1, 1996.
