An Act relating to the State Board of Education;
making appropriations thereto; stating purposes;
and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Six Million Three Hundred Seventeen Thousand Five Hundred Forty-five Dollars (\$6,317,545.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to the State Board of Education for student growth supplement funding to school districts for the 1994-95 school year as provided in subsection C of Section 18-200 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Six Million Seven Hundred Seventy Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-nine Dollars (\$6,770,799.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to the State Board of Education for student growth supplement funding to school districts for the 1995-96 school year as provided in subsection C of Section 18-200 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Fifteen Million Eighty-two Thousand One Hundred Ninety-seven Dollars (\$15,082,197.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to the State Board of Education for student growth supplement funding to school districts for the 1996-97 school year as provided in subsection C of Section 18-200 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
