A Concurrent Resolution relating to the purchase of certain property by the Department of Environmental Quality; authorizing certain property purchase; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 247, enacted by the Legislature during the 1st Session of the 45th Legislature, authorized the Department of Environmental Quality to purchase, upon legislative authority, a property not to exceed Three Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,200,000.00) for the purpose of providing staff offices and laboratories; and

WHEREAS, the Department, through the state bidding process, has located a property at 707 N. Robinson Street in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, which satisfies its office and laboratory needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Department of Environmental Quality is authorized to purchase the real property located at 707 N. Robinson Street in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, for a price not to exceed Three Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,200,000.00).

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Governor, the Secretary of Environment and the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality.
