A Concurrent Resolution memorializing the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation to urge the United States Congress to take action authorizing the levying and collecting of sales and use taxes on catalog sales; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Bellas-Hess United States Supreme Court decision restricted the levy of sales and use taxes on certain catalog sales; and

WHEREAS, a more recent ruling by the United States Supreme Court in Quill Corporation v. North Dakota, 112 S Ct 904, noted that the United States Congress has the ultimate power to resolve this interstate commerce issue; and

WHEREAS, many services offered by the states are being eliminated or curtailed, and state infrastructure needs are not being adequately funded; and

WHEREAS, state and local governments in the State of Oklahoma could receive approximately \$52 million in estimated sales and use tax collections on catalog sales to help continue services and products and to repair and construct infrastructure necessary to adequately serve our citizenry.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature memorializes the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation to take appropriate measures to assist in passage of legislation to require mail order vendors to levy and collect appropriate sales and use taxes.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the State of Oklahoma's Washington, D.C. office for distribution to the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation.
