A Resolution declaring May 2, 1995, as Burt Richardson Day in the State of Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Burt Richardson was born in Dallas, Texas, on May 2, 1895, and will be 100 years of age on May 2, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Burt Richardson was a cross-country runner at Texas University before he joined the United States Army during World War I; and

WHEREAS, Burt Richardson retired as a manager of F.W. Woolworth in January 1961 and the next month became a banker at Central National Bank in Enid, Oklahoma. He is the oldest currently-working banker in the nation; and

WHEREAS, both the Mayor of Enid and Governor of Oklahoma have declared May 2, 1995, as Burt Richardson Day. A reception will be held for Mr. Richardson at the bank from 1 to 3 p.m. on his 100th birthday in commemoration of his working for Central National Bank of Enid for more than a third of a century - 34 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate declares May 2, 1995, as Burt Richardson Day in the State of Oklahoma.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Burt Richardson on his 100th birthday celebration at Central National Bank in Enid, Oklahoma.
