A Resolution recognizing the importance of Little League Baseball; declaring June 10-16, 1996, as National Little League Week in the State of Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Little League Baseball gives an avenue whereby young Americans can channel their energy and efforts for a positive reward. Little League Baseball encourages teamwork, sportsmanship and healthy competition; and

WHEREAS, Little League Baseball is encouraging both as a game to watch and a contest in which to participate. Little League Baseball is a program of service to youth, geared to provide an outlet of healthful activity and training under good leadership in the atmosphere of wholesome community participation; and

WHEREAS, Little League Baseball is dedicated to helping children become good and decent citizens. It strives to inspire them with a goal and to enrich their lives toward the day when they must take their places in the world. It establishes for them rudiments of teamwork and fair play. Little League Baseball has made the benefits of its program available to millions of children since 1939 and has resulted in a sound and proven framework of workable local league organization and procedures; and

WHEREAS, there are Little League Baseball programs in Tulsa, Broken Arrow, Dewey, Chickasha, Miami, Northeastern Oklahoma (located in Picher), Wynadotte, Grove, Cherokee County (located in Tahlequah), Pawhuska, Barnsdall, Guymon, Panhandle (located in Beaver) and Copan, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, National Little League Week is scheduled for June 10th through June 16th, 1996.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate recognizes the importance of Little League Baseball.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate proclaims June 10th through June 16th as National Little League Week in the State of Oklahoma.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Mr. Jack Greenawalt, Oklahoma District Administrator of Little League Baseball, for distribution to all Little League programs in the State of Oklahoma.
