An Act relating to supplemental appropriations;
making appropriations to the Oklahoma State Regents
for Higher Education, the State Board of Vocational
and Technical Education, the Department of
Corrections, and the Oklahoma Corporation
Commission; stating purposes; amending Section 3,
Chapter 276, O.S.L. 1994, which relates to
budgetary limits of the Department of Corrections;
modifying expenditure limits; amending Section 18,
Chapter 268, O.S.L. 1994, which relates to
budgetary limits of the Oklahoma Department of
Veterans Affairs; modifying expenditure limits;
amending Section 13, Chapter 350, O.S.L. 1992, as
amended by Section 6, Chapter 277, O.S.L. 1994 (62
O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 57.312), which relates to
duties of the State Treasurer; modifying
contracting entity; modifying fund for deposit;
making certain appropriations nonfiscal; making
certain appropriations fiscal; repealing Section 3,
Chapter 254, O.S.L. 1994, Section 67, Chapter 262,
O.S.L. 1994, and Section 7, Chapter 277, O.S.L.
1994 (62 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 57.315), which
relate to the Building Bond Revolving Fund; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education by law.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, the sum of One Million Nine Hundred Forty-four Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$1,944,273.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the duties imposed upon the Department of Corrections by law.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to fully fund payroll in fiscal year 1995.

SECTION 5. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 276, O.S.L. 1994, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Corrections by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Seventy-two Thousand One Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$72,180.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995. The Department of Corrections for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Corporation Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, the sum of Three Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$388,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of preventing an agency-wide furlough.

SECTION 7. AMENDATORY Section 18, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 1994, is amended to read as follows:

Section 18. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs by law shall be set by the War Veterans Commission of Oklahoma. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-six Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$56,375.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 8. AMENDATORY Section 13, Chapter 350, O.S.L. 1992, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 277, O.S.L. 1994 (62 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 57.312), is amended to read as follows:

Section 57.312 The State Treasurer shall invest all sinking fund monies in direct obligations of the United States of America or in certificates of deposits from banks in the State of Oklahoma acceptable as depositories by the State Treasurer when such certificates of deposits are secured by acceptable collateral and yield as much or more than direct obligations of the United States of America, to mature in time to meet the principal and interest payments on the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992. Such earnings shall be deposited in the sinking fund, except that any funds received pursuant to a contract entered into by the Office of the State Treasurer for the investment of revenues dedicated for bond repayment may be deposited in the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury.

SECTION 9. The appropriations made by Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 10. The appropriation made by Section 6 of this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1995. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1995, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 11. REPEALER Section 3, Chapter 254, O.S.L. 1994 and Section 67, Chapter 262, O.S.L. 1994, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 12. REPEALER Section 7, Chapter 277, O.S.L. 1994 (62 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 57.315), is hereby repealed.

SECTION 13. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
