An Act relating to appropriations; amending Section 121, Chapter 187, O.S.L. 1994 and Sections 3, 76 and 77, Chapter 262, O.S.L. 1994, which relate to effective and operative dates of appropriations to various state agencies and appropriations to the State Board of Education; modifying effective dates; modifying operative dates; modifying period for which appropriations may be used; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The appropriations made in Sections 2 and 3 of Chapter 187, O.S.L. 1994, shall become effective August 1, 1994.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 121, Chapter 187, O.S.L. 1994, is amended to read as follows:

Section 121. Sections 1, and 4 through 120 of this act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 262, O.S.L. 1994, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Mineral Leasing Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, the sum of Four Hundred Eighty-nine Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-four Dollars (\$489,784.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 4. AMENDATORY Section 76, Chapter 262, O.S.L. 1994, is amended to read as follows:

Section 76. The appropriation made by Sections 1 and 3 of this act for Financial Support of Public Schools shall become operative August 1, 1994.

SECTION 5. AMENDATORY Section 77, Chapter 262, O.S.L. 1994 is amended to read as follows:

Section 77. Sections 2, and 4 through 75 of this act shall become operative July 1, 1994.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
