An Act relating to appropriations; making appropriations to the State Board of Education, the State Supreme Court, the Court of Criminal Appeals, and the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector; amending Sections 25, 52, 53, 54 and 131 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 837 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, which relate to appropriations and effective dates; modifying fund from which certain appropriation is made; modifying amounts of various appropriations; modifying effective dates; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Four Hundred Twenty-six Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-two Dollars (\$426,462.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Early Intervention Program.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Supreme Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for computer systems enhancements.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Court of Criminal Appeals from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-eight Dollars (\$124,458.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for computer systems enhancements.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for

the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector by law.

SECTION 5. AMENDATORY Section 25 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 837 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 25. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to provide uniform computer systems development, including computer software for county government, in accordance with the State Auditor and Inspector's duties to prescribe accounting procedures and to provide technical assistance to county government. The appropriation made in this section shall be expended exclusively for the purpose so stated and shall not be transferable.

SECTION 6. AMENDATORY Section 52 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 837 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 52. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State Treasurer from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of Three Million One Hundred Seventy Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars (\$3,170,498.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the State Treasurer by law.

SECTION 7. AMENDATORY Section 53 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 837 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 53. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State Treasurer from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of One Million Thirty-three Thousand One Hundred Fifty-four Dollars (\$1,033,154.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay for bank service charges.

SECTION 8. AMENDATORY Section 54 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 837 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 54. There is hereby appropriated to the State Land Reimbursement Fund from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Cash-flow Reserve Fund, designated by the Office of State Finance as the "095" Fund, the sum of Ninety-seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$97,500.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to make payments to counties for agricultural land free of homesteads which is owned by the state as school or park land.

SECTION 9. AMENDATORY Section 131 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 837 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 131. Sections 7, 13, 17, 28, 54, 64, 69 and 74 of this act shall become effective June 1, 1996. Sections 1 through 6, 8 through 12, 14 through 16, 18 through 27, 29 through 53, 55 through 63, 65 through 68, 70 through 73, and 75 through 129 of this act shall become effective July 1, 1996.

SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
