A Concurrent Resolution congratulating the Edmond North High School boys golf team for their "three-peat"; recognizing the efforts of golf coach Mike McGraw and his Husky golf team; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Edmond North High School boys golf team won the 1994 Class 4A state championship, the 1995 5A state title and accomplished a "three-peat" by winning the title again this year. Members of the Edmond North Huskies 1996 Class 5A State Golf Champions include Tosh Hays, Tyler Willey, Matt Larson, Derrick Taylor, Greg Larson, J. J. Belcoff, Matt Moore, Bryan Schones, Vaughn Marshall, Kyle Willmann, Kevin Earls, Brandon Pearson and Ryan Butts. The coach is Mike McGraw; and

WHEREAS, Edmond North Golf Coach Mike McGraw has been a part of eleven state championships, eight while assisting at Memorial High School and the last three in a row at Edmond North. Stressing confidence, composure and concentration, the Edmond North golf coach had his traditional "haircut" at the hands of a team member following the victory; and

WHEREAS, Edmond North senior Derrick Taylor was named to the "All-State Team" in 1996, won the "Gut-Check" Award and the Bill Nicklas Memorial Scholarship. Edmond North senior Tyler Willey had eight top-ten finishes during his senior year and placed 6th in the Class 5A State Meet in 1996 and was designated as the "Most Improved Player" in 1996. Sophomore Matt Larson made the All Conference Team for 1996, placed 7th in the Class 5A State Meet in 1996 and set a Husky record for the lowest score for 36 holes by a sophomore. Greg Larson earned All-Conference honors for 1996 and shot a one under par 69 to set a new Husky record for a sophomore golfer; and

WHEREAS, Tosh Hays captured the South Central PGA Junior Tournament of Champions title. Tosh was All-Conference in 1995 and 1996. He was on the "All-State Team" in 1996 and was the Edmond North Most Valuable Player in 1996. He placed second in the Class 5A State Meet, which was one of his eleven top-ten finishes in 1996.
