AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to counties and county officers;
amending Section 2, Chapter 220, O.S.L. 1992 (19
O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 8.2), which relates to the
County Home Rule Charter Act; modifying county
population requirement for adopting a county home
rule charter; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 220, O.S.L.
1992 (19 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 8.2), is amended to read as
follows:

Section 8.2 Any county in this state with a population of ~~less~~
more than ~~five hundred fifty thousand (550,000)~~ five hundred
thousand (500,000), according to the latest Federal Decennial
Census, which contains a metropolitan area with a population of two
hundred fifty thousand (250,000) or more, according to the latest
Federal Decennial Census, may adopt or amend a County Home Rule
Charter for county government which specifies those powers
appropriate for said government and which are not inconsistent with
the Oklahoma Constitution and laws of this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
