AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to labor; amending Section 34, Chapter 356, O.S.L. 1994 (40 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 2-802), which relates to certain employee reports relating to child support enforcement; making reporting mandatory; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 34, Chapter 356, O.S.L. 1994 (40 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 2-802), is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-802. A. Employers doing business in the State of Oklahoma ~~may~~ shall report to the Department of Human Services, Child Support Enforcement Division, the hiring or employment of any person who resides or works in this state to whom the employer anticipates paying earnings.

B. Such report may contain the employee's name, address, social security number and date of birth, date of employment and information regarding availability of employee dependent health care coverage, along with the employer's name, address and federal

identification number. The report may be made by mailing a copy of the employee's W-4 form, by submitting a fax transmission of the employee's W-4 form, by submitting electronic media in a format that can be used by the Child Support Enforcement Division, or by any other means authorized by the Child Support Enforcement Division.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
