HOUSE BILL NO. 1215

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;  
designating certain highway as the "Mickey Mantle  
Highway"; providing for the Oklahoma Department of  
Transportation to place permanent markers;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1625 of Title 69, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 20/82 from the intersection of State Highways 20  
and 82, also known as the Spavinaw "Y", south to Spavinaw Creek  
shall be designated the "Mickey Mantle Highway" as a lasting tribute  
to not only one of the greatest players ever to wear the Yankee  
pinstripes, but one of the greatest players to ever play the game of  
baseball, America's pastime. The Oklahoma Department of  
Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed  
upon the highway bearing said name and designating Spavinaw as the  
birthplace of Mickey Mantle.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
