AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 1991, Section 24-116, which relates to high school diplomas; modifying requirements for awarding diploma upon completion of certain college work; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1991, Section 24-116, is amended to read as follows:

Section 24-116. Any person who is a legal resident of this state and has been admitted to any accredited college or university ~~may~~ shall be awarded a high school diploma by the State Department of Education ~~within this state, provided that such~~ after the person has successfully completed at least thirty (30) credit hours of college work at an accredited college or university.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
