AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; prohibiting operation of a motor vehicle while wearing a headset; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-1115 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No person shall drive a motor vehicle while wearing a headset. For purposes of this section, "headset" means any device that is intended to convert electrical energy into sound waves and is worn over or inserted into the ear.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
