HOUSE BILL NO. 1489

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 1991, Section 7-108, which relates to electioneering; setting penalty for electioneering; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 1991, Section 7-108, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7-108. No person shall be allowed to electioneer within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box while an election is in progress, nor shall any person or persons, except election officials and other persons authorized by law, be allowed within fifty (50) feet of any ballot box while an election is in progress. No printed material other than that provided by the election board shall be publicly placed or exposed within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box, while an election is in progress. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to incarceration in the county jail for not more than six (6) months, a fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or both such incarceration and fine.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
