AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to fees; amending 28 O.S. 1991, Section 86, which relates to jurors' fees; increasing fee and mileage paid to jurors; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 28 O.S. 1991, Section 86, is amended to read as follows:

Section 86. Jurors shall be paid the following fees out of the Court Cash Fund: For each day's attendance before any court of record, ~~Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)~~ Thirty-four Dollars (\$34.00); for each mile necessarily traveled in going to or returning from the place of attendance, ~~twenty-two cents (\$0.22)~~ thirty-four cents (\$0.34), and such mileage shall be allowed each day that said mileage is incurred.

The Court Fund Board of the district court may contract for or provide reimbursement for parking for district court jurors to be paid from the Court Fund. Parking so provided to jurors shall be in lieu of any reimbursement to jurors for parking fees.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1996.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
