AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to officers; amending 51 O.S. 1991, Section 94, which relates to ouster of certain officers; increasing the number of citizens required to verify notice to the Attorney General to instigate investigation and ouster proceedings; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 51 O.S. 1991, Section 94, is amended to read as follows:

Section 94. It shall be the duty of the Attorney General of this state, when directed by the Governor, or upon notice being received by ~~him~~ the Attorney General in writing and verified by ~~five~~ two hundred or more reputable citizens of the county before some officer authorized to administer oaths, that any officer herein mentioned has been guilty of any of the acts, omissions or offenses as set out in Section, ~~3~~ 93 of this ~~act~~ title, to forthwith investigate such complaint, and if on such investigation ~~he~~ the Attorney General shall find that there is reasonable cause for such complaint, ~~he~~ the Attorney General shall forthwith institute proceedings in the Supreme Court of the state, or any district court

of the county of the residence of the accused, to oust such officer from office.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
