HOUSE BILL NO. 2765

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
abolishing the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission, the
Transportation Commission, the Oklahoma Turnpike
Authority, and the Waterways Branch with the
Oklahoma Department of Transportation Planning
Division; transferring powers, duties and
responsibilities; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4019 of Title 69, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Effective January 1, 1997, the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission,
the Transportation Commission, the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, and
the Waterways Branch within the Oklahoma Department of
Transportation Planning Division are hereby abolished. The powers,
duties and responsibilities exercised by the entities listed in this
section pursuant to law shall be transferred to the Oklahoma
Department of Transportation. Any statutory references to the
entities listed in this section shall mean the Oklahoma Department

of Transportation. All records, employees, property, matters pending and funds of any of the entities listed in this section shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 1997.
