AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety;

providing for certain employment contracts relating to nurses aides; authorizing certain employment contracts to contain certain provisions; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1951 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any nursing facility administrator entering into an employment contract for the services of a nurses aide and such contract requires training, the employment contract may include a provision that a nurses aide who voluntarily resigns from employment with the nursing facility will be charged for the costs incurred by the facility for the training of the nurses aide if the nurses aide does not remain employed with the nursing facility for at least six (6) months. For purposes of this section the term "voluntary" shall not include forced resignations due to illnesses or deaths of family members.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
