AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to professions and occupations;
amending 59 O.S. 1991, Section 738.1, as amended by
Section 4, Chapter 207, O.S.L. 1995 (59 O.S. Supp.
1995, Section 738.1), which relates to power of
certain boards to grant injunctions; clarifying
language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 1991, Section 738.1, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 207, O.S.L. 1995 (59 O.S. Supp. 1995, Section 738.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 738.1 Injunctions, without bond, may be granted by district courts to the Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners, the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, the Board of Examiners in Optometry, the Board of Pharmacy, or the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners, for the purpose of enforcing the respective acts and laws creating ~~and establishing~~ these boards.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
