AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commemorating Don S. Reynolds of Del City, Oklahoma, for his years of outstanding service to this country, the State of Oklahoma, and to his community, church and family; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Don S. Reynolds has a long list of accomplishments in his service to the United States and the State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, some of these accomplishments include:

1. Member of the Rose State College Board of Regents since March 3, 1971;
2. Member of the Commission of 100 to Reform State Government;
3. Member of the United States Air Force Association. Member of the United States Army, serving 4 years in World War II and 2 years in the Korean Conflict;
4. Past President of the American Field Service Chapter for Foreign Exchange Students;
5. Past President of the Central Oklahoma Chamber of Commerce;
6. Past President of the Del City Chamber of Commerce;
7. Past President of the Del City Historical Society;
8. Past President of the Del City Lions Club;
9. Former Mayor and City Councilman of Del City (12 years);
10. Former Certified Lay Speaker for the United Methodist Church;

11. Active Teacher, Homebuilder Adult Class at the Sunny Lane United Methodist Church (35 years); and

12. Former Member of the Bi-District Board of Missions for the Oklahoma Conference of the United Methodist Church (15 years); and

WHEREAS, even with this long list of state, community and religious accomplishments, Don S. Reynolds still made time for his loving family, including his wife Lois married to Mr. Reynolds since Christmas Eve of 1939, their two daughters, five granddaughters and one great grandson; and

WHEREAS, citizens like Don S. Reynolds deserve the utmost gratitude from the people of this state for their unselfishness in giving their time and efforts in service to the state, community, church and family.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
