AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to prisons; requiring the Department of Corrections to establish an Infirmary Care Unit at Mabel Bassett Correctional Center; providing for equipment and staff; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 509.6 of Title 57, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Corrections shall establish an Infirmary Care Unit at Mabel Bassett Correctional Center in Oklahoma City, State of Oklahoma for the benefit of all female offenders at either medium or maximum security classification levels in the custody of the Department. The unit shall be appropriately equipped and staffed to provide twenty-four-hour medical care and treatment as may be necessary for immediate medical treatment, recovery from medical care or childbirth, long-term medical care and other medical services.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
