AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending Section 7, Chapter 347, O.S.L. 1992, as amended by Section 19, Chapter 332, O.S.L. 1993 (63 O.S. Supp. 1995, Section 1-121), which relates to the Oklahoma Health Care Information System Act; clarifying statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 7, Chapter 347, O.S.L. 1992, as amended by Section 19, Chapter 332, O.S.L. 1993 (63 O.S. Supp. 1995, Section 1-121), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-121. The State Department of Health, until July 1, 1994, and thereafter, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, shall issue reports no less than annually which may include recommendations to the Oklahoma Legislature for any change in the statutes needed to further the purposes of the Oklahoma Health Care Information System Act, Section 1-115 et seq. of this title. The initial report shall be submitted by January 1, 1993. The initial report shall include but not be limited to an implementation schedule for the development and completion of the health care information system and the status of compliance with the health care information and data submission requirements of the Division. The system shall be fully functional and operative by January 1, 1995. Subsequent reports may include plans for expanding the uniform data base to other medical providers including, but not limited to, all

licensed health care professionals or entities providing health care services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
