AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; transferring supervision, management and control of certain institutions; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4651 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The governance, supervision, management and control of University Center at Tulsa and Rogers State College is hereby transferred from the Board of Trustees of University Center at Tulsa and the Board of Regents of Rogers State College to the Board of Regents of University Center at Tulsa and Rogers State College, and all property, assets and obligations of University Center at Tulsa and Rogers State College and any and all obligations of the Board of Trustees of University Center at Tulsa and Board of Regents of Rogers State College for and on behalf of University Center at Tulsa and Rogers State College are hereby transferred to the Board of Regents of University Center at Tulsa and Rogers State College. Obligations for any and all plans for tenure or retirement of employees of University Center at Tulsa and Rogers State College, either through University Center at Tulsa or Rogers State College or

the Board of Trustees of University Center at Tulsa and the Board of Regents of Rogers State College, shall be assumed by the Board of Regents of University Center at Tulsa and Rogers State College.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1996.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
