AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to property; prohibiting owner or possessor of land from obstructing certain right-of-way for utilities; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 57.1 of Title 60, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No owner or possessor of land may obstruct or allow the obstruction of an easement or right-of-way for utilities including, but not limited to, an easement by necessity for ingress and egress.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
