AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; prohibiting certain members of any political party from doing business with the State of Oklahoma; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4249 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No national or state committee chair, vice-chair or other officer of any political party recognized by this state shall conduct any business with this state.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
