AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to preservation of civil order and safety; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts by the Department of Civil Emergency Management; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of Director; providing budgetary limitations; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts by the Office of the State Fire Marshal; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of the State Fire Marshal; providing budgetary limitations; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts by the Military Department; providing for duties and compensation of employees; providing budgetary limitations; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the Department of Civil Emergency Management shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Civil Emergency Management by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Forty Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-three Dollars (\$40,553.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The Department of Civil Emergency Management for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

OFFICE OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL

SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the Office of the State Fire Marshal shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law shall be set by the State Fire Marshal. The salary of the State Fire Marshal shall not exceed Forty-four Thousand Sixty Dollars (\$44,060.00) per annum,

payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The Office of the State Fire Marshal for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

MILITARY DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA

SECTION 5. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 6. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma by law shall be set by the Adjutant General. The Military Department of the State of Oklahoma for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
