AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care

Authority; providing for duties and compensation of
employees; limiting the salary of the
Administrator; authorizing compensation for certain
expenses of the Administrator; providing certain
budgetary limitations; providing an effective date;
and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA HEALTH CARE AUTHORITY

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not
otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law shall be set by the
Administrator. The salary of the Administrator shall not exceed
Zero Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 1996. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is
authorized to pay professional expenses of the Administrator of the
Authority, including dues, licenses, professional memberships,
continuing medical education classes conducted in the State of
Oklahoma, and medical malpractice insurance. The Oklahoma Health

Care Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
