AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to counties and county officers;
amending 19 O.S. 1991, Section 215.29, which
relates to district attorney and firearms;
authorizing an assistant district attorney to carry
a firearm with certain approval; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 1991, Section 215.29, is amended to read as follows:

Section 215.29 A district attorney, or assistant district attorney with the approval of a district attorney, may carry a firearm ~~on his person~~ to use only for personal protection if ~~he~~ the district attorney or assistant district attorney has successfully completed an approved course of firearm training conducted by a state certified firearms instructor which meets the minimum requirements for firearms training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
