AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the sentencing powers of the court; repealing 22 O.S. 1991, Sections 991a, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 308, O.S.L. 1994 and 991a, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 40, O.S.L. 1994 (22 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 991a), which relate to the sentencing powers of the court and which are duplicate sections; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. REPEALER 22 O.S. 1991, Section 991a, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 308, O.S.L. 1994, and 991a, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 40, O.S.L. 1994 (22 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 991a), are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
