AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 1991, Section 14-105, which relates to absentee voting; modifying application for absentee ballots; allowing registered voters to vote by certain facsimile device; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 1991, Section 14-105, is amended to read as follows:

Section 14-105. Any registered voter may apply for an absentee ballot ~~either~~ in person at the county election board, by United States mail, ~~or~~ by telegraph or by facsimile device as defined by Section 1862 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall prescribe a form to be used for said application, although any ~~written or telegraphed~~ application setting forth substantially the same facts shall be valid.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
