AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to driving under the influence of alcohol; repealing 47 O.S. 1991, Sections 11-902, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 308, O.S.L. 1994 and 11-902, as last amended by Section 5, Chapter 387, O.S.L. 1994 (47 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 11-902), which relate to driving under the influence of alcohol and which are duplicate sections; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. REPEALER 47 O.S. 1991, Sections 11-902, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 308, O.S.L. 1994 and 11-902, as last amended by Section 5, Chapter 387, O.S.L. 1994 (47 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 11-902), are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
