AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring State Board of Education to solicit proposals and award grants for certain pilot projects; stating certain attributes of pilot projects; requiring State Department of Education to determine certain criteria and to establish a certain process; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.581 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Board of Education shall solicit proposals for, and if funds are available award grants for, pilot projects that establish a school site for the delivery of educational services which focus on the arts.

B. The State Department of Education shall determine pilot project criteria and establish a process for the consideration of proposals. The proposals shall be considered on a statewide competitive basis.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
