

SHORT TITLE: Refueling service; requiring certain service stations and other facilities to offer refueling service at self-service price to disabled drivers under certain conditions; codification; effective date.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to refueling service; requiring certain service stations and other facilities to offer refueling service at self-service price to disabled drivers under certain conditions; requiring Oklahoma Corporation Commission to provide certain notices; authorizing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 451 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each service station or other facility in this state which offers gasoline or other motor vehicle fuel for sale to the public from both full-service and self-service pumps shall offer refueling service at the self-service price to a disabled driver of a motor vehicle, provided:

1. The vehicle displays a physically disabled license plate issued pursuant to Section 1136 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes or issued by another state and which displays the international accessibility symbol which is a stylized human figure in a wheelchair; and

2. The disabled driver is not accompanied by another person capable of refueling the motor vehicle.

B. As used in this section, "refueling service" means the act of pumping gasoline or other motor vehicle fuel into the fuel tank of a motor vehicle.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 452 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Corporation Commission shall provide a notice setting forth the provisions of this act and rules promulgated pursuant thereto to each service station or other facility in this state which offers gasoline or other motor vehicle fuel for sale to the public at the time a permit is issued or renewed pursuant to Section 301 et seq. or Section 401 et seq. of Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. The Oklahoma Corporation Commission shall provide a notice setting forth the provisions of this act and rules promulgated pursuant thereto for distribution by the Oklahoma Tax Commission to each person who is issued a physically disabled license plate in this state at the time the plate is issued or renewed.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 453 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Corporation Commission is authorized to promulgate rules necessary for the implementation of this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 1995.
