AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Oklahoma education services and support; providing the State Board of Education with certain spending limits; providing for duties and compensation of employees; providing budgetary limitations; providing the Commissioners of the Land Office with certain spending limits; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salaries of the Secretary and the Assistant Secretary; providing budgetary limitations; providing the State Board of Vocation and Technical Education with certain spending limits; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; providing the Oklahoma Teacher Preparation Commission with certain spending limits; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; providing the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics with certain spending limits; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Director; providing

budgetary limitations; providing an effective date;  
and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

EDUCATION

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the State Board of Education shall budget all funds in the following categories:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Department of Education by law shall be set by the State Board of Education. The State Department of Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Commissioners of the Land Office by law shall be set by the Secretary of the Commission. The salary of the Secretary shall not exceed Sixty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-six Dollars (\$62,876.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. The salary of the Assistant Secretary shall not exceed ninety percent (90%) of the Secretary's salary per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. The Commissioners of the Land Office for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 6. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Vocational and Technical Education by law shall be set by the Board. The salary of the Director of the State Department of Vocational and Technical Education shall not exceed Eighty-one Thousand Four Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$81,420.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. The Oklahoma Department of Vocational and Technical Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 7. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the Commission for Teacher Preparation shall budget all funds in the following categories:

SECTION 8. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation by law shall be set by the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation. The salary

of the Executive Director shall not exceed Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. The Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 9. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall budget all funds in the following categories:

SECTION 10. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-nine Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-two Dollars (\$59,662.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. The Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 11. This act shall become effective July 1, 1996.

SECTION 12. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
