AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to vocational and technical

education; making an appropriation to the State  
Board of Vocational and Technical Education from  
the Cash-flow Reserve Fund; stating purpose; making  
appropriation nonfiscal; providing an effective  
date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Cash-flow Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education by law.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1996.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
