AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to preservation of civil order;
making an appropriation to certain agencies;
providing purpose for appropriation; requiring
repayment of certain funds; specifying repayment
shall be made to the Constitutional Reserve Fund;
providing for noncodification; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the affected agencies from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of funding the payroll requirements necessary to administer affected programs.

SECTION 2. Upon receipt of federal funds received pursuant to an appropriation or continuing resolution enacted by the federal government to provide funds for the payroll or administration of said programs; the agency shall immediately repay any funds provided in Section 1 of this act which have not yet been expended.

Upon receipt of federal funds received pursuant to an appropriation or continuing resolution enacted by the federal government to provide for retroactive payment to cover funds expended on the payroll or administration of the affected program during the federal budgetary impasse, or to provide for reimbursement to the state for funds expended during that same period, the agency shall immediately repay the total amount of funds provided in Section 1 of this act.

Any and all funds repaid pursuant to this section shall, without exception, be deposited directly into the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
