AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Office of State Finance;

making appropriations thereto; stating purposes;
providing for the budgeting and lapsing of funds;
providing an operative date; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of State Finance from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purpose of conducting a detailed study of the State Insurance Fund and to make recommendations concerning the sale or privatization of the fund. Funds appropriated by this section may be budgeted and expended for employing or contracting with individuals or firms with expertise in this area.

SECTION 2. This act shall become operative July 1, 1996.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
