AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to fees; amending 28 O.S. 1991,
Section 106, which relates to court costs and fees;
providing for disposal of certain unexpended court
costs; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 28 O.S. 1991, Section 106, is amended to read as follows:

Section 106. A. It shall be the duty of the court clerk receiving any costs or fees belonging to any other person, to deposit the same in the court fund subject to the order of the person entitled thereto, and to pay the same over on request; and if such costs or fees shall not be claimed within three (3) years after having been received, except in all cases where jurisdiction is continuing, and three (3) years after final judgment, they shall become the property of the court fund, provided that any unexpended court costs or money in excess of Five Dollars (\$5.00) belonging to litigants shall be mailed by the court clerk to the proper attorney of record.

B. The court clerk shall have no duty to collect costs or fees due from litigants totalling Five Dollars (\$5.00) or less after three (3) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
