AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; limiting application of certain provision; requiring certain voters to indicate school district of residence; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 13A-107 of Title 26, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The provision in subsection B shall apply only to precincts divided by two or more school districts that are holding concurrent school elections.

B. Prior to being issued a ballot or ballots, persons who have been determined to be registered voters by the clerk in the precinct where the concurrent elections are being held, shall, in the presence of the clerk, sign the proper precinct registry and indicate on the registry his or her school district of residence.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
