RESOLUTION NO. 1

AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution prohibiting C. Michael Williams from entering Senate premises or discussing pending matters with Senate members or staff; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, C. Michael Williams, 1030 South Sycamore Drive, Grove, Oklahoma, is currently under investigation by state investigative agencies on allegations of misconduct arising from lobbying activities; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Senate finds and declares that high moral and ethical standards are essential to the orderly conduct of the Senate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT, during the pendency of investigations of alleged wrongdoing by C. Michael Williams, said C. Michael Williams, while engaging in lobbying activities, as defined by Section 4202 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for compensation, is prohibited from entering areas of the State Capitol that are under the control of the Oklahoma State Senate, including the Senate Chamber lobby, Senate members' offices, Senate staff offices, and hallways and lobbies immediately adjoining such offices.

THAT, during the pendency of investigations of alleged wrongdoing by C. Michael Williams, said C. Michael Williams, while engaging in lobbying activities, as defined by Section 4202 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for compensation, is prohibited from discussing matters pending before the Oklahoma State Senate with members of the Oklahoma State Senate and Senate employees.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to members and employees of the Oklahoma State Senate.
