AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution congratulating the Margaret Hudson Program, Inc. upon its selection for the 1995 Child Abuse Prevention Fund Outstanding Project Award; proclaiming May 1, 1995, as Margaret Hudson Program Day in the State Capitol; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Margaret Hudson Program, Inc., is a comprehensive program of academics, health and social services to pregnant and parenting teens in Tulsa County, Oklahoma. The program has served over 6,000 teen families since 1968; and

WHEREAS, in January 1992, the Margaret Hudson Program opened a campus in Owasso, Oklahoma, located in the Presbyterian Church. They have served over 50 young families from Owasso, Collinsville, Sperry and Skiatook. The funding to provide the program has been a joint effort of community support through the United Way and a grant from the Office of Child Abuse Prevention of the Oklahoma State Department of Health; and

WHEREAS, on April 18, 1995, the Margaret Hudson Program was notified that it had been selected to receive the State Interagency Child Abuse Prevention Task Force 1995 Child Abuse Prevention Fund Outstanding Project Award. The award ceremony will be held May 2, 1995, at the luncheon meeting of the Healthy Families Oklahoma '95 Conference at the Hilton Inn Northwest in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Margaret Hudson Program will be participating in the Children's Day activities at the State Capitol in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on May 1, 1995.
