CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to children; creating certain revolving funds for the Office of Juvenile Affairs; creating the 200 Revolving Fund, the 400 Revolving Fund, and the 410 Revolving Fund; stating purposes; providing for deposits and expenditures of the fund, and procedures related thereto; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7302-4.3 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Department of Juvenile Justice, to be designated the "200 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of nonfederal funds received by the agency. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office of Juvenile Affairs for general operations. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7302-4.4 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Office of of Juvenile Affairs, to be designated the "400 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of federal Title IVE and Title XIX funds. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office of Juvenile Affairs for general operations.

Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7302-4.5 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Office of Juvenile Affairs, to be designated the "410 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of federal program grants. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office of Juvenile Affairs for general operations. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 1998.
