COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.
1991, Section 662, which relates to display areas
for historical documents; modifying location
requirement for State Constitution display case;
providing location requirement of State Seal;
requiring display areas be under jurisdiction and
control of Secretary of State; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 662, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 662. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized and
directed to establish secured display areas for the original State
Constitution, photographs and other documents and articles of

historical significance. The original State Constitution shall be displayed in a display case to be designated by the Secretary of State ~~on the first floor of~~ in the State Capitol Building, ~~which.~~
The original State Seal shall be displayed at the Oklahoma Territorial Museum in Guthrie, Oklahoma. The display area areas shall be a part of the office of, and under the jurisdiction and control of, the Secretary of State, and the State Constitution shall there be preserved under the control, jurisdiction and supervision of the Secretary of State.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
